It is important to minimize the number of people on the showgrounds at any one time. Every effort has been made to make your time at the show as efficient as possible. We are working to get our show online as much as possible to help with this!

Here are the answers to some of your frequently asked questions:

Who will be permitted on the showgrounds?

- Access will be limited to essential personnel only, trainers, grooms, Exhibitors and immediate family members residing in the same residence.
- In compliance with current protocols for the State of California's reopening of "Professional Sports" (without live audiences), spectators are not allowed. Unfortunately, that means extended family members, friends, personal photographers, etc.

How will access be monitored?

- Every person accessing the showgrounds is required to submit a [Waiver Of Liability](#).
- The Waiver will be available online available for downloading, 48 hours prior to move-in day.
- The waiver covers a single show and a new waiver must be submitted each show.
- Once submitted and approved, you will receive a wrist band
- We plan to have volunteers at Gate C to accept your signed waiver and give you wrist bands.
- The wristband **MUST** be worn during the entire show.

Are tack room set-ups allowed?

- Yes, as long as you maintain social distancing at all times.
